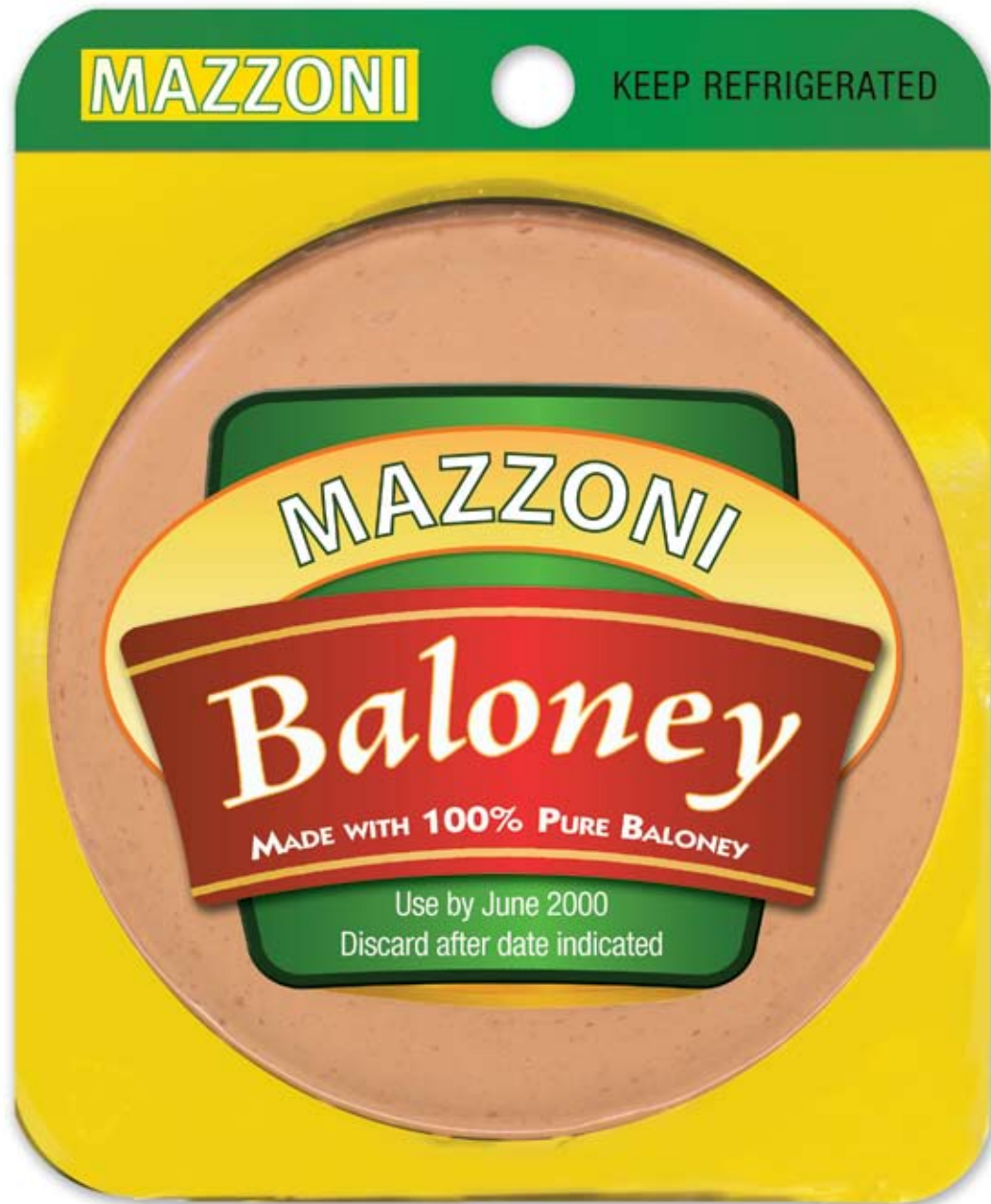


Don't buy it



Kerry Mazzone says our County government is in crisis and she is the one to fix it.

That's Baloney. Here are the facts:

Baloney: Marin County Supervisors spent “millions on establishing the MEA (Marin Energy Authority).” (*Mazzone handout*) and MEA has “cost taxpayers \$2,000,000 and counting.” (*Mazzone mailer*)

Fact: Marin County provided only \$540,000 in loan money for MEA, a program that is on track to provide clean energy for ratepayers and completely repay the County's portion of loan money by this time next year.

Baloney: “Marin faces a \$20 million deficit.” (*Mazzone handout*)

Fact: Marin County has a balanced budget, having reduced a projected deficit to zero through restructuring and staff reductions. Marin has a AAA bond rating, one of the lowest debt ratios of the 58 California counties and a healthy reserve for a rainy day. Susan Adams has voted **NO** to pension and salary increases, including for the Supervisors. She takes **NO** car allowance and is **NOT** enrolled in the County pension plan.

Warning: read this before buying Mazzone Baloney.

Energy: Mazzone was a co-author of AB 1890, a bill that brought us energy deregulation, rolling blackouts and the Enron debacle. As an Assemblymember she received thousands in donations from PG&E during the time it was being bailed out by taxpayers to the tune of \$16 Billion. Pension problem: Candidate Mazzone claims to want “sweeping reforms” of County employee pension programs, but as Assemblywoman, Mazzone voted for SB 400, the bill that created enriched pensions and contributes to the problems she complains of today. (*<http://tinyurl.com/33adfj9>*)

THE COMPANY MAZZONE KEEPS: In her last term of the Assembly, Mazzone received thousands from the insurance industry, PG&E, Enron, other energy and oil companies and development interests. (*<http://tinyurl.com/3xgx2c7>*)

Then, she went to work as a Sacramento lobbyist. In Marin, she lobbies for the Marin Builders Association among others. As a lobbyist for builders, how will she vote on important land use issues in the County? (*<http://www.teamgsi.net/index.html>; Form 700, on file at the Marin County Registrar of Voters Office.*)

Now Mazzone takes money from road building, development and quarrying interests. (*FPPC reports on file with the Marin County Registrar of Voters and Mazzone's Facebook page.*)

Susan Adams reports all donors, large and small. Mazzone refused a request to do the same. (Marin IJ, 05/10/2010.)

Baloney: Mazzone claims her 1990's experience as an Assemblywoman can work to enhance Marin's economy and fix pensions.

Fact: Mazzone has no record on issues in the First District. Mazzone, the Assemblywoman, voted for enhanced and retroactive pensions for State employees, contributing to the pension problems facing local governments today. (*SB 400, 1999. See sidebar for more information.*)

Baloney: Mazzone can help Marin Schools.

Fact: County Supervisors have **NO** jurisdiction over schools, which are the purview of Marin's School Districts and the Superintendent of Schools.

The recession created challenges for everyone.
That doesn't mean we have a crisis in Marin.
Don't buy Mazzone Baloney.

Susan Adams is the real deal. She protects the taxpayers' pocketbook and the health and quality of life of our County.

She works for us.
